28 **IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between Petitioner, COLEMAN LAFFOON,**
individually, and by and through his attorney of record, FREID AND GOLDSMAN, A
Professional Law Corporation, by Jon S. Summers, and Respondent, ANNE HECHHE,
individually, and by and through her attorneys of record, JAFFE AND CLEMENS, by Nancy
Braden-Parker, as follows:

CHILD CUSTODY AND VISITATION

1. **Petitioner and Respondent shall have temporary physical custody of the minor**
child, Homer Laffoon, born March 2, 2002, during the following times as hereinafter described:
 - a. **Commencing May 7, 2007, Respondent shall have physical custody of the**
minor child from after school on May 7, 2007 until after school on May 14, 2007. Petitioner
shall vacate the family residence during this temporary physical custody period.

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1 b. Petitioner shall have physical custody of the minor child from after school
2 on May 14, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on May 20, 2007. Respondent shall vacate the family residence
3 during this custodial time.

4 c. Respondent shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
5 on May 20, 2007 until after school on May 25, 2007. Petitioner shall vacate the family residence
6 during this temporary physical custody period.

7 d. Petitioner shall have physical custody of the minor child from after school
8 on May 25, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on May 27, 2007. Homer and Petitioner shall vacate the family
9 residence during this temporary physical custody period.

10 e. Respondent shall have physical custody of the minor child from after
11 school on May 27, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on June 3, 2007. Petitioner shall vacate the family
12 residence during this temporary physical custody period.

13 f. Petitioner shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
14 on June 3, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on June 17, 2007. Respondent shall vacate the family residence
15 during this temporary physical custody period.

16 g. Respondent shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
17 on June 17, 2007 until after school on June 22, 2007. Petitioner shall vacate the family
18 residence during this temporary physical custody period.

19 h. Petitioner shall have physical custody of the minor child from after school
20 on June 22, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on June 24, 2007. Homer and Petitioner shall vacate the family
21 residence during this temporary physical custody period.

22 i. Respondent shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
23 on June 24, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on July 1, 2007. Petitioner shall vacate the family residence
24 during this temporary physical custody period.

25 j. Petitioner shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
26 on July 1, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on July 22, 2007. The Automatic Temporary Restraining Orders
27 shall be waived only to the extent that Petitioner may take the minor child out of the state of

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1 California during the prescribed time period set forth in this Paragraph. Petitioner shall drop off
 2 the minor child to Respondent at the Vancouver Airport.

3 k. Respondent shall have physical custody of the minor child from 5:00 p.m.
 4 on July 22, 2007 until 5:00 p.m. on August 12, 2007. Respondent shall drop off the minor child
 5 at the conclusion of her custodial time at the Los Angeles International Airport.

6 2. The custody schedule to be in effect following August 12, 2007 shall be
 7 determined by further agreement of the parties or if the parties cannot agree, by further order of
 8 Court.

9 3. During the periods of Respondent's custodial time from June 24, 2007 until
 10 August 12, 2007, the Automatic Temporary Restraining Orders shall be waived only to the
 11 extent that Respondent may take the minor child to Vancouver.

12 4. The custodial parent shall deliver the Minor Child to the non-custodial parent at
 13 the conclusion of the custodial parent's time, unless other arrangements are made in advance by
 14 the parties.

15 5. Each party shall refrain from making derogatory remarks about the other to or in
 16 the presence of the minor child.

17 6. If the custodial parent is unable to care for the minor child for a period of four (4)
 18 hours or more, the custodial parent shall first offer that time to the other parent.

19 7. Each party shall ensure that the minor child attends preschool during his/her
 20 custodial time.

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 SUPPORT

22 8. Respondent shall pay to Petitioner, as and for support for the month of May 2007,
 23 the sum of \$19,000, payable forthwith. Said support shall be allocated \$5,000 as child support
 24 and \$14,000 as spousal support. Said support shall be made without prejudice to any contentions
 25 either party may make concerning (a) Respondent's ability to pay child and/or spousal support to
 26 Petitioner, and/or (b) Petitioner's need for child and spousal support from Respondent. Any
 27 orders made by the Court regarding support shall be retroactive to May 1, 2007. Respondent

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1 shall receive credit for any support payments made by her against the support ordered by the
2 Court.

3 **CHILD CUSTODY EVALUATION**

4 9. The parties shall submit to an Evidence Code section 730 child custody
5 evaluation to be performed by mutually agreed upon evaluator or by an evaluator to be selected
6 by the Court if the parties are unable to agree.

7 10. This Stipulation may be executed in signed counterparts, each of which shall be
8 deemed to be an original. A facsimile copy of this Stipulation may serve as an original for all
9 purposes.
